

Severe Weather - Flooding Potential

This Weekend

Key Messages

- → Wind gusts of 30-40 mph are likely today.
- → Slight Risk for severe thunderstorms Friday evening through Sunday. Highest chances Friday night with large hail and damaging winds.
- Several rounds of heavy rainfall will likely lead to at least isolated instances of flash flooding and increased river levels this weekend.



Important Updates

→ Increased rainfall amount probabilities. A Moderate (level 3 of 4) risk for excessive rainfall has been outlined for a large portion of the forecast area on Saturday.




The atmosphere will be conducive for scattered strong to severe thunderstorms Friday evening and Friday night.

Be weather aware and ready to act. Have multiple ways to receive warning information!





Today and Friday


Timing



Southerly winds will be the strongest by Thursday afternoon with gusts of 35-40 mph, locally up to 45 mph, especially for areas near the I-49 corridor.

Winds start to diminish by Friday evening.

Rainfall Timing this Weekend



Rainfall chances will continue to be refined as we get closer; however, rainfall chances are now above 70% for Saturday and Sunday.

There still could be dry time in between rounds of thunderstorms.



Rainfall Probs (Friday - Sunday Night)




Probability of > 1.00" of rain



River Flood Potential

Highlights

- Long range ensemble forecasts are showing increasing percentages for near action stage along the Spring, James, Marmaton and especially the Jacks Fork Rivers.
- The image to the right is not a hydrograph but instead a probability of occurrence for the James River at Galena, Missouri.
- Currently there is a 29% chance of exceeding action stage at this location within the next 10 days.
- Locations along creeks and rivers will need to monitor the situation closely this weekend.











Confidence Details

- → Confidence is medium to high that showers and thunderstorms will occur intermittently throughout the weekend.
- → There is a medium chance for severe thunderstorms to occur on Friday with the cold front moving through the area.
- → There is a low-medium probability of severe thunderstorms to occur again on Sunday.
- Confidence is increasing in the potential for heavy rain and flooding.
