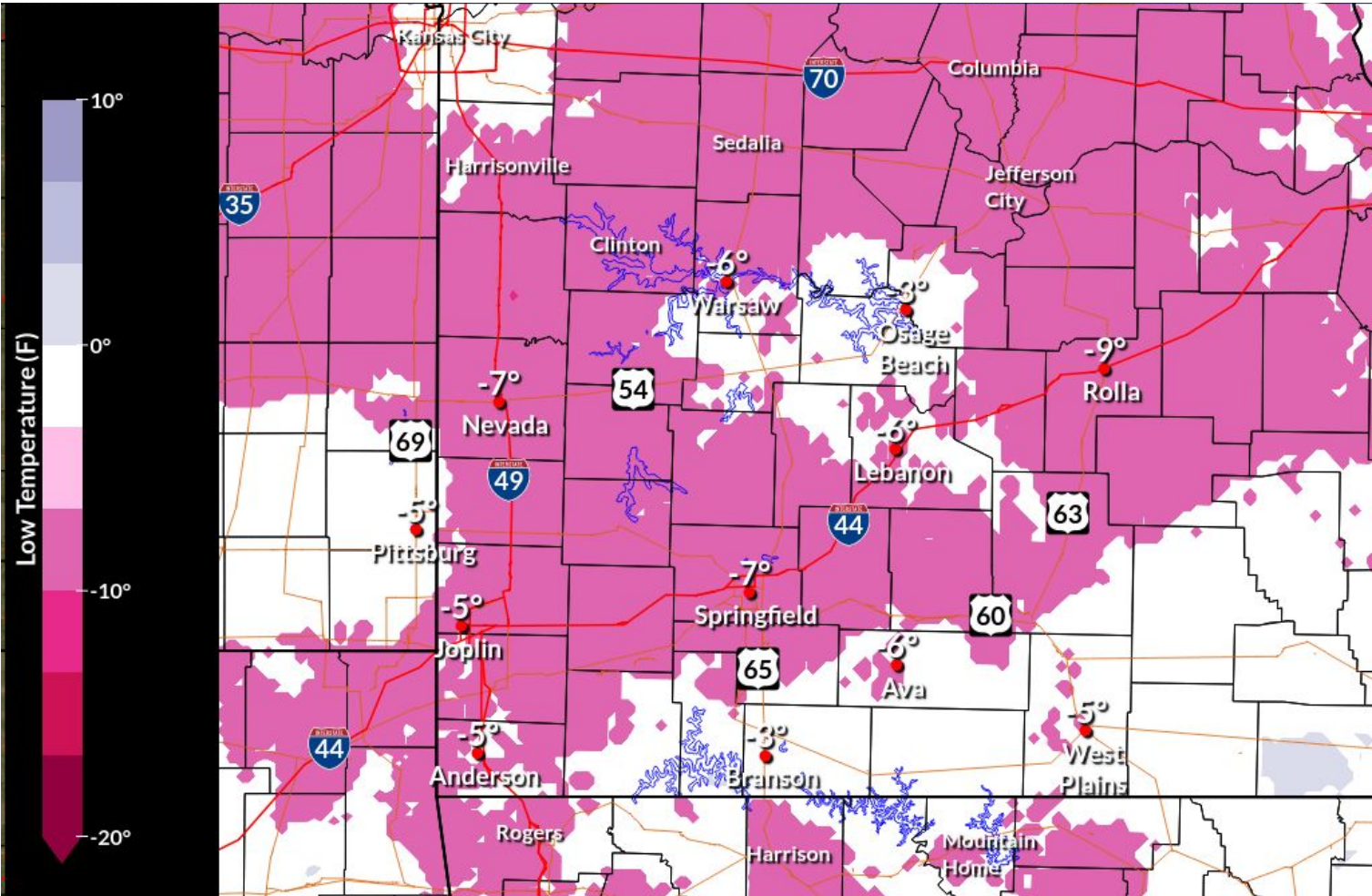




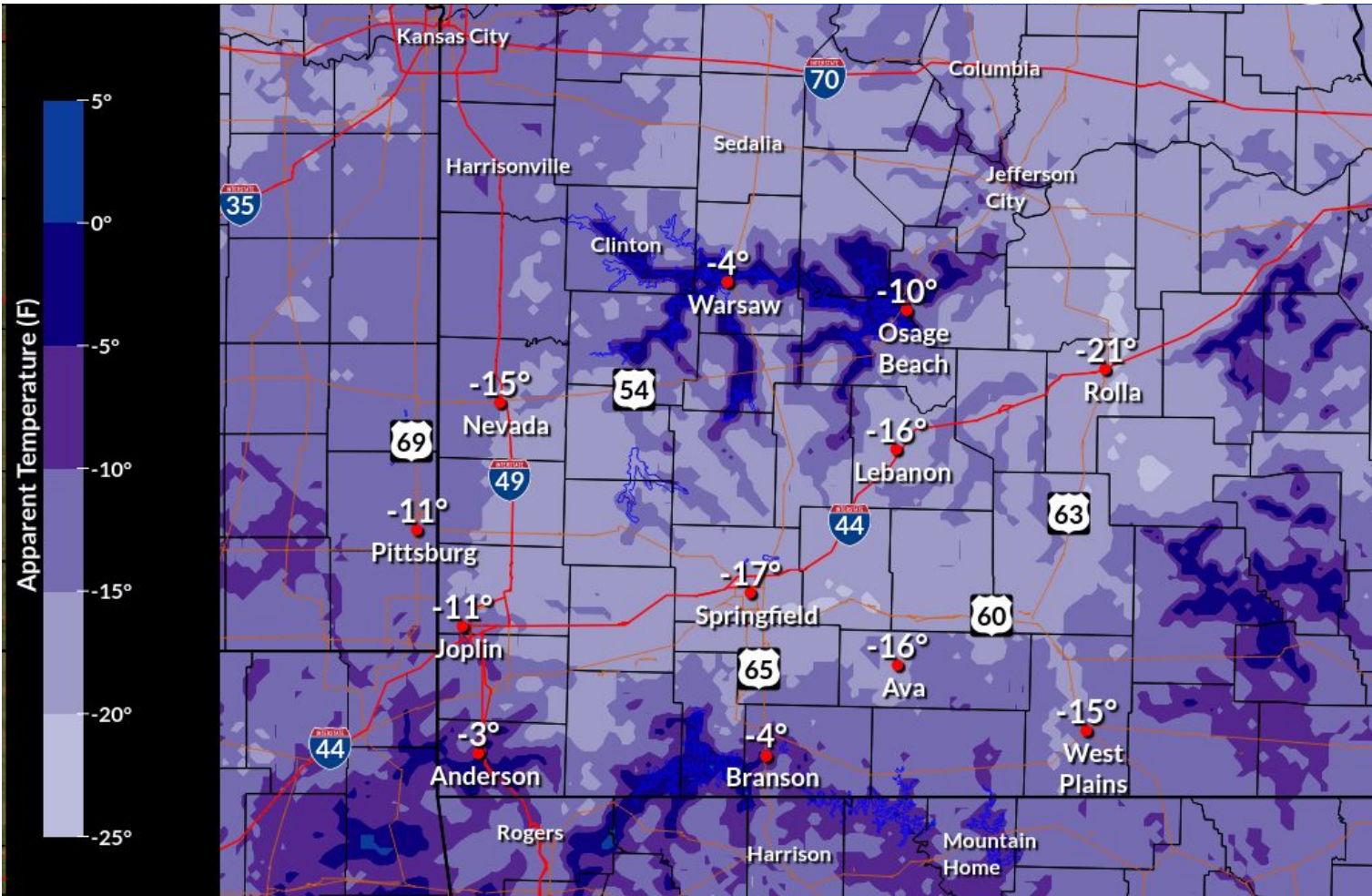
Forecast Low Temps & Wind Chills

Minimum Wind Chill Tonight

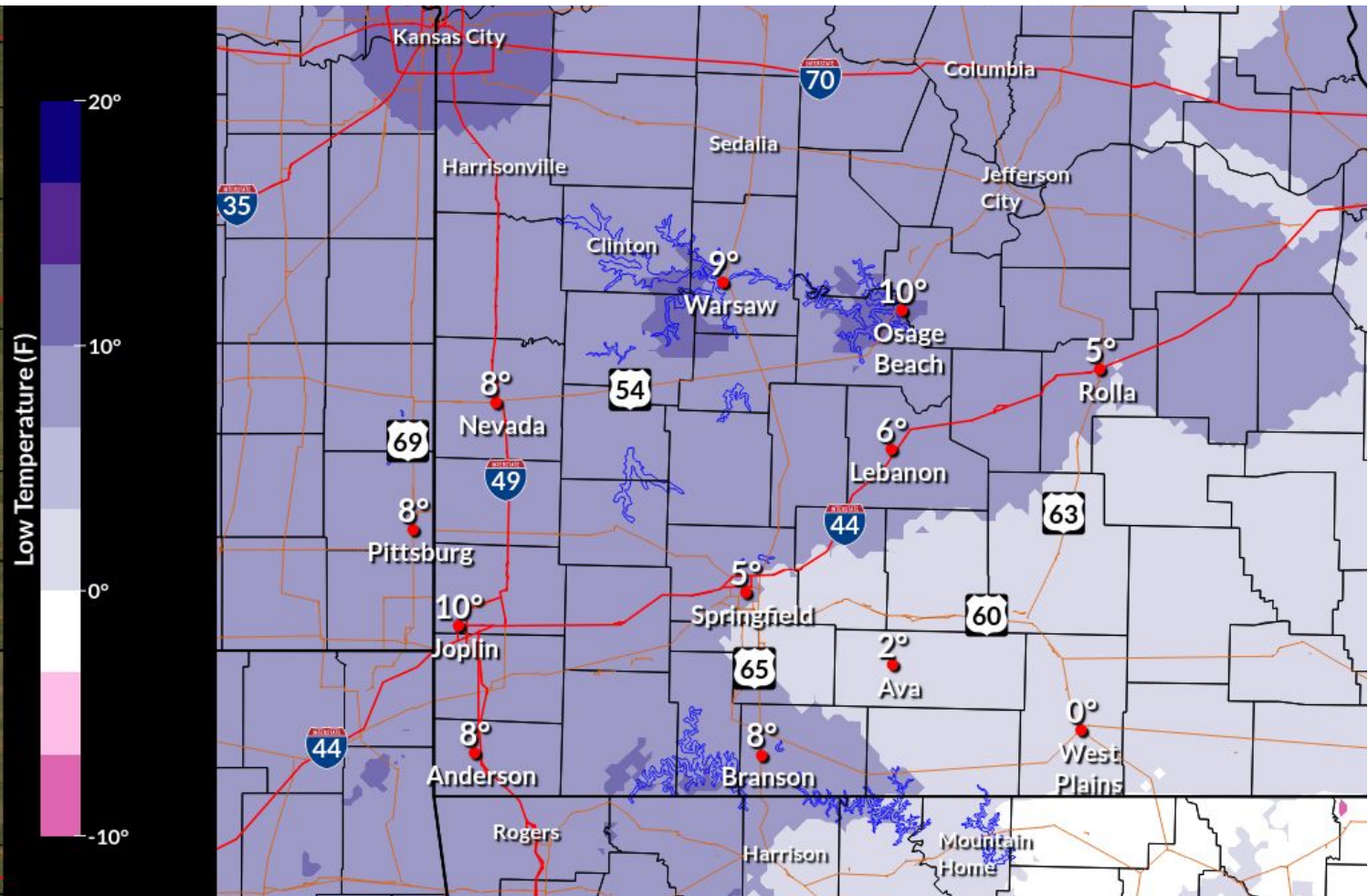




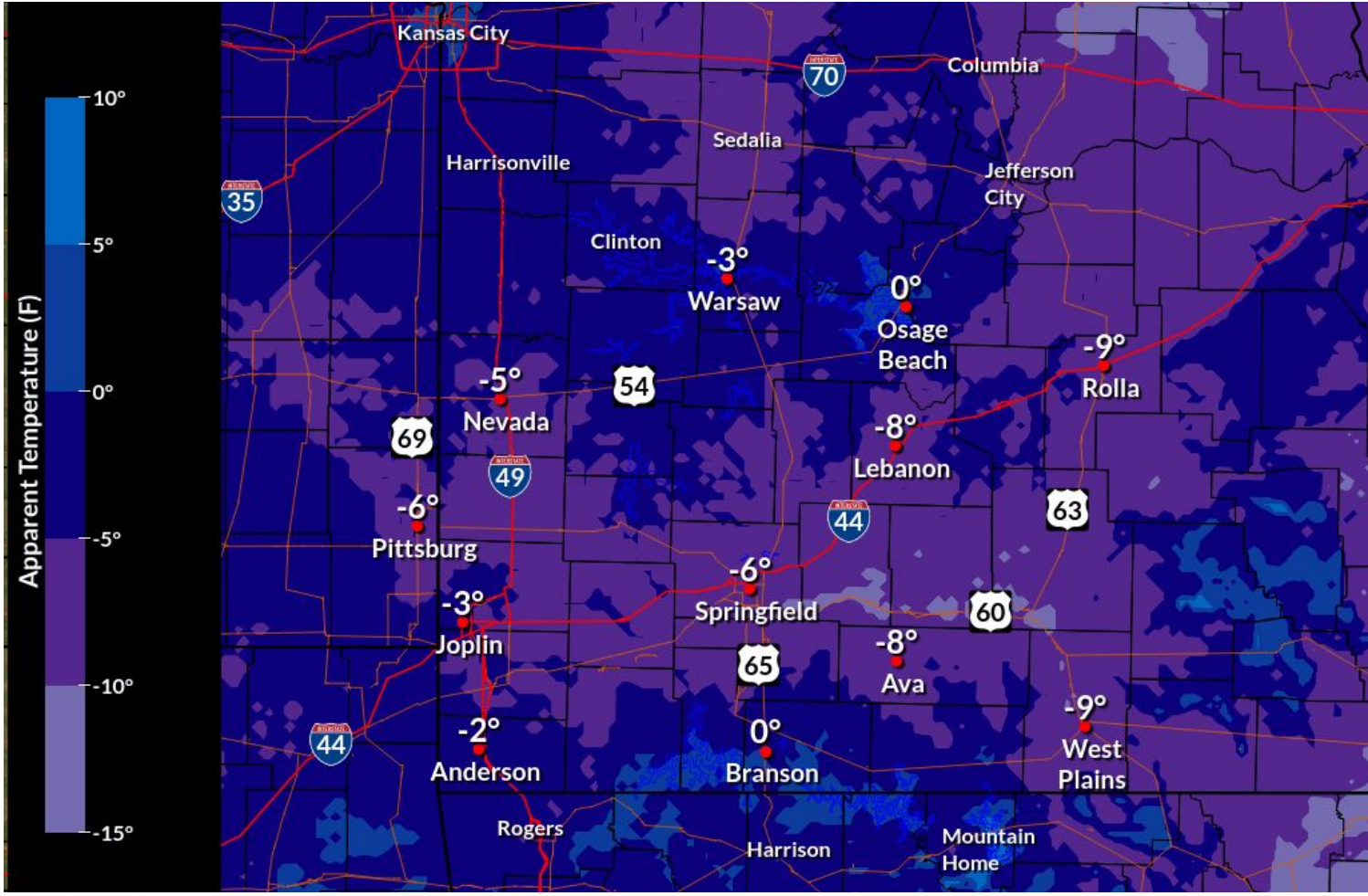

Forecast for next several days

- Behind the winter storm, high temperatures in the 20s and 30s through Thursday, along with lows in the single digits and teens, will extend the time it takes for any snow on the ground to melt.
- Breezy winds 15-25 mph Monday evening into Tuesday morning could push loose snow around.
- More sunshine will occur Monday through midweek, but temperatures will remain near or below freezing, which will limit the snow melt.

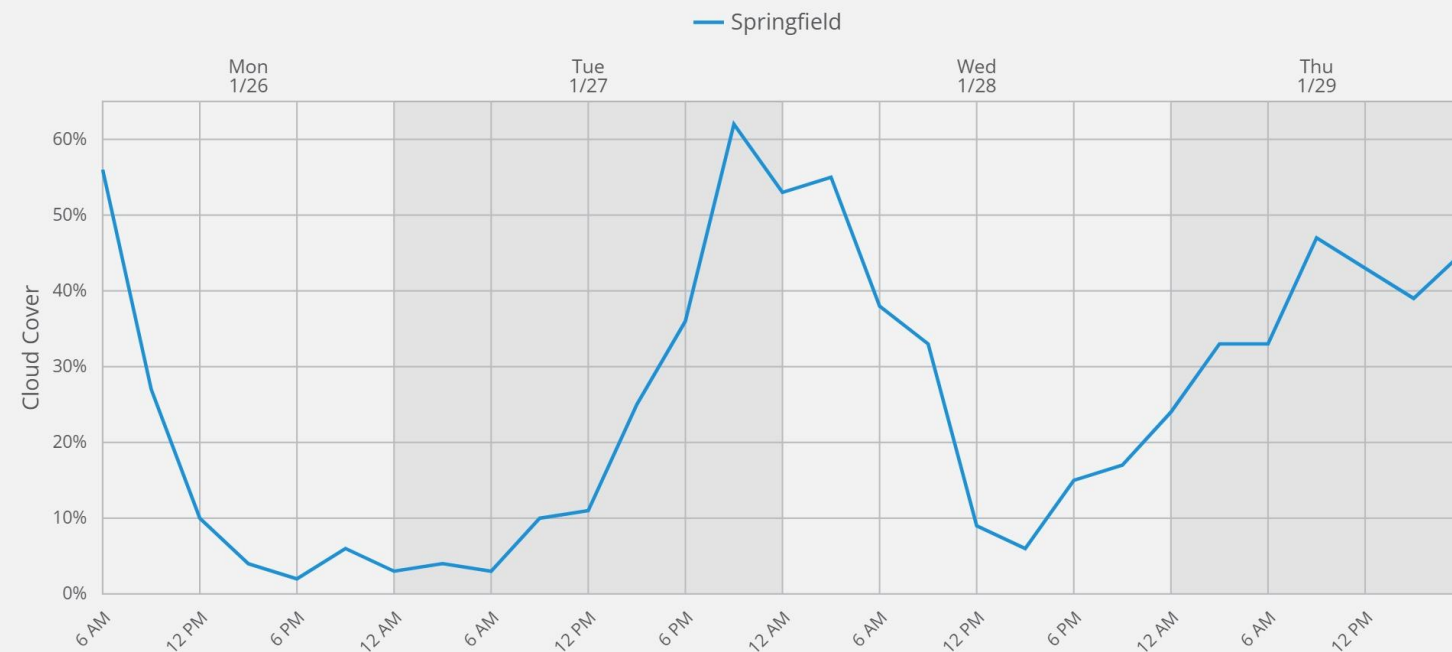

DON'T FORGET YOUR PETS



Even with a natural fur coat, **winter can be deadly** for your pets unless proper care is given.



Keep them warm and dry, and indoors whenever possible.



Provide plenty of food and water. Dehydration is especially dangerous in winter.



When outside, keep them bundled up. Limit outside time, and thoroughly clean (including paws) when bringing them in
